Online Applications

Microsoft Office 365 and Google Apps for Education

Log in are via their DET portal: Learning, using their DET username and password.

Microsoft Office 365 and Google Apps for Education are now available for use by all DEC teachers and students. Both sets of tools are used around the world to support teaching and learning, and offer a wide range of educational benefits. These online services will assist schools in using a Bring Your Own Device strategy, allowing students and staff to collaborate from any device, anywhere they have access to the internet.

Microsoft Office 365 is a set of web-based applications that enable collaboration and creation in the classroom. This service includes online versions of popular Office products such as Word, Excel, Sway and PowerPoint. In addition, Microsoft Office 365 offers collaboration and sharing opportunities via OneDrive and OneNote.

Google Apps for Education (GAFE) is a suite of web-based applications which help teachers and students work collaboratively on documents, spreadsheets, presentations and more. The service includes easy ways to conduct surveys and forms, as well as Google Classroom, a way to manage assignments online.
