### Principal's Report

- Ian reported on the COVID-19 climate at the school.
- Thanked the Committee for supporting the teachers with two Wednesdays of lunches.
- All students returning 25<sup>th</sup> May.
- Wednesdays: Sport requires a 1:10 ration teacher to students. Year 10 leaves early and Yrs 8 & 9 do sport. Wednesdays include Band and Duke of Ed.
- School fees will go out with a covering letter and a 10% reduction in fees across the year.
- The school has leased two new buses. One is 17 seat and one is 11 seat.

### President's Report

- Canteen.
  - Thank you to Kath Gunn and Di Cutrie for their work in getting the JobKeeper organised for 3 staff members. This was a new and complicated process.
  - Thank you to the staff of the Canteen & Uniform Store. Changes happened at fast rates and they accepted these changes
  - We have been able to get the Cookbooks moved to a new storage area during this time. Thank you to Science for allowing us to store them in their prep room.
  - Canteen staff are on a limited Roster at the moment and will return to normal hours and full staff from 25<sup>th</sup> May
  - P&C provided lunches for two Wednesdays for teachers. Approximately 24 the first week. Teachers were blown away by the generosity. They also loved being able to buy themselves a coffee at the local coffee shop. Thanks to Vanessa Edwards for organising.
