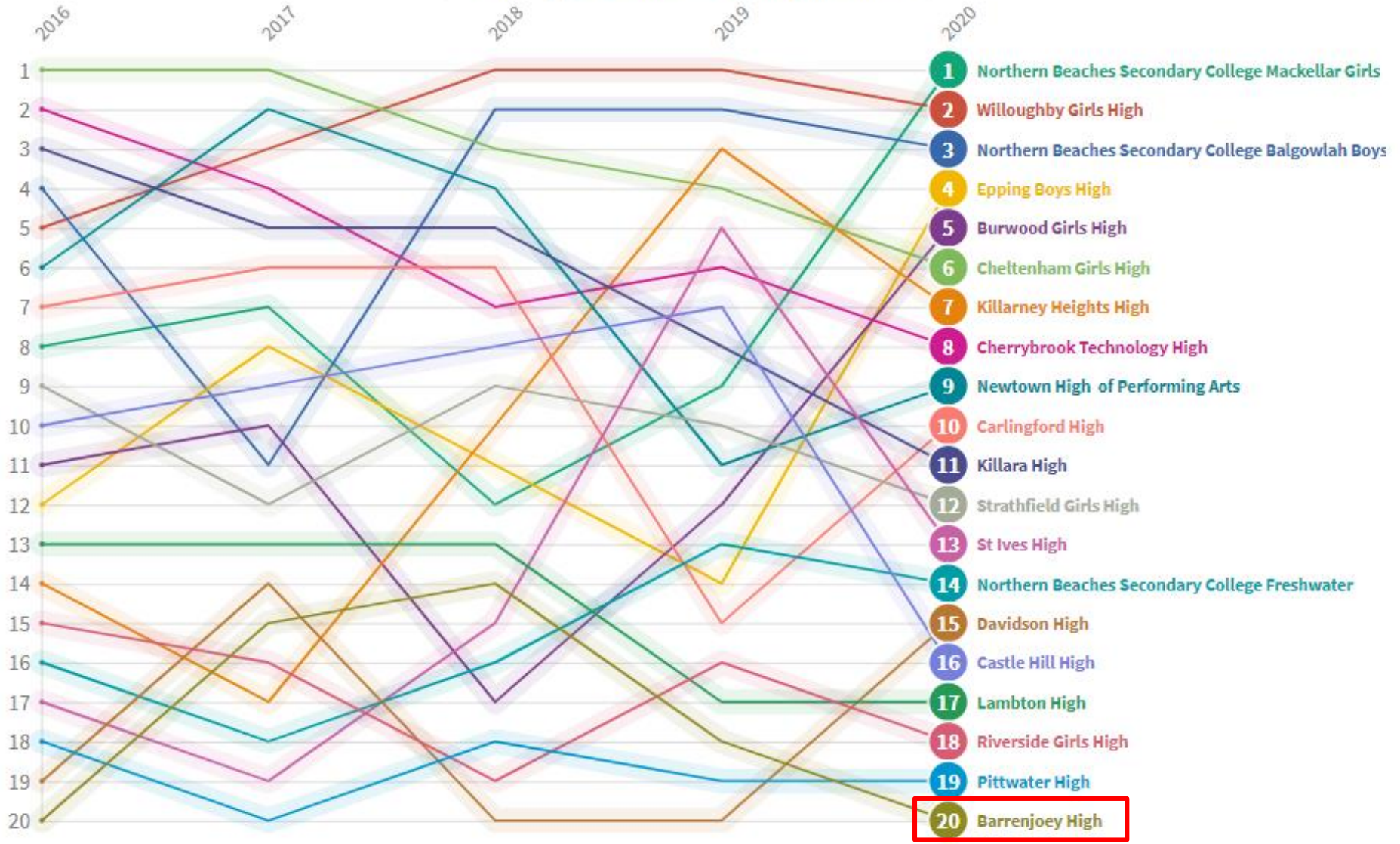

SCHOOL GROUP STATISTICS



- 91 Year 12 students for the HSC and 23 Accelerated Year 11 students sat their HSC in Business Studies.
- **46 results (10.7%)** were placed in the top band, Band 6. This is similar to previous years and continues the solid results of the past 10 years.
- **155 results (36%)** were in the second band, Band 5.
- In total **77%** of all HSC results were placed in the top three bands. This now means Barrenjoey students have been substantially above the state average for the last 10 years, displaying terrific cultural improvements for all students.
- In total an incredible 14 students (15%) received all their results in the top two bands. This amounts to great recognition for their hard determined work.
